Tokyo, December 14, 2016 - Nippon Life Insurance Company (President: Yoshinobu Tsutsui, hereinafter "Nippon Life") today announced the completion of an investment in bonds issued by the African Development Bank (hereinafter "AfDB"), with the theme "Improve the quality of life for the people of Africa" (hereinafter "the Bonds") (in Private Placement format, USD100 million, approximately JPY11.4 billion). This marks the world's first issuance of such Bonds targeted to institutional investors. *¹

AfDB's mission is to combat poverty by promoting sustainable economic development and social advancement in Africa.

The theme of the Bonds, "Improve the quality of life for the people of Africa", is one of the principal pillars of the five development priority areas of AfDB, referred to as the High 5s^{*2}, and aims to substantially improve the health and quality of life of people on the continent. The net proceeds from the issuance of the Bonds will support AfDB projects such as those promoting improved access to water and sanitation services.

Nippon Life has been proactively investing in ESG areas such as Green Bonds and Woman Bonds, and this investment is part of the activity.

To thrive together with regions, society and the environment, and share in the benefits of stable growth with other companies and the economy as a whole, Nippon Life will continue to focus on investment in the ESG area.

Below are examples of projects that might be financed by the bond with the theme "Improve the quality of life for the people of Africa".

- 1. Four Towns Water Supply and Sanitation Improvement Program, Ethiopia
 - Total Project Amount: USD114 million, approximately JPY12.9 billion (of which AfDB invested USD76 million, approximately JPY8.6 billion)
- 2. Water Supply Program in Rural Areas, Tunisia
 - Total Project Amount: USD140 million, approximately JPY15.9 billion (of which AfDB invested USD105 million, approximately JPY11.9billion)
- Urban Water Reform and Port Harcourt Water Supply and Sanitation Project, Nigeria
 Total Project Amount: USD 346 million, approximately JPY39.3 billion (of which AfDB invested USD 200 million, approximately JPY22.7 billion)
